The Iowa Food Bank Association (IFBA) is comprised of six trusted Feeding America food banks that work together to:

- Educate and advocate for policies that eliminate food insecurity
- Efficiently and effectively serve lowans facing hunger

Choose Iowa

Expand and increase the current state appropriation for lowa food banks to purchase local and lowa-produced foods:

 Increase current appropriation for food banks to purchase Iowa-grown, produced or processed foods in Choose Iowa program to distribute to Iowans.
 Food banks will provide matching funds.

Double Up Food Bucks

Increase funding for Double Up Food Bucks, a program that helps low-income lowans purchase fresh fruits and vegetables through SNAP:

 \$1 million annual appropriation to support Double Up Food Bucks, administered by Iowa's Healthiest State Initiative

SNAP Education

Educate lawmakers about how SNAP (Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program) benefits farmers and those experiencing hunger across lowa.
